 - B. Her current state was untenable.
 - (***1 Peter 3:7, Lamentations 1:1***)
- II. Elisha's Response (***2 Kings 4:2***)
 - A. What shall I do for you?
 - B. What do you have in the house? (***John 6:9***)
- III. The Widow's Reply
 - A. Your servant has nothing, except a jar of oil.
 1. Prepare for Relationship (***Ruth 3:3***)
 2. Prepare for Worship (***2 Samuel 12:20***)
 - B. The oil was still in the house.
- IV. Elisha's Instructions (***2 Kings 4:3-4***)
 - A. God has the volume. He just needs a vessel. (***Judges 7***)
 - B. Willingness + God's Resources = Limitless Potential
 - C. Protection is part of God's provision. (***Mark 5:39-40***)
- V. The Widow's Obedience (***2 Kings 4:5-6***)
 - A. The miracle came through the work of her own hands.
 - B. A little power, combined with God's provision, is more than enough. (***Revelation 3:8***)
 - C. "Lord, expand our capacity!"
