- I. Compromise in Conflict (Genesis 13:10-11)
 - A. Be on guard when conflict arises.
 - B. Lot sold out for the world.
 - 1. He became comfortable in a place of sin.
 - 2. He left a legacy that was less than ideal.
- II. Compromise of Convictions (1 Kings 11)
 - A. Solomon was a man of strong convictions.
 - 2 Chronicles 8:11; 1 Kings 3:14
 - B. 3 Truths to Remember
 - 1. The enemy seeks to exploit where you're gifted
 - 2. Once you live for YOU...It will never be enough.
 - 3. It's still okay to have Godly convictions!
- III. Compromise of Covenant
 - A. Asa became unequally yoked. (2 Chronicles 16:3)
 - B. He gave away what belonged to the Lord.
 - C. He took this covenant to his grave. (16:9-13)
- IV. Compromise of the Kingdom
 - A. Jehoshaphat was on the right path. (2 Chron. 17:3-9)
 - B. He was seduced by the enemy. (2 Chronicles 18:2)
 - C. He aligned with a kingdom not of his own.

THE MAIN POINT: Compromise will ALWAYS lead you into idolatry, and when unaccounted for, spiritual death. Repent, and hold fast to the Word of God.
