 - A. A desperate situation.
 - B. Her vision was clouded.
 - C. Her hope was lost, and now her memory was stolen.

- II. An Encounter with Christ **(v. 14-16)**
 - A. Mistaken identity.
 - B. Consumed with despair.
 - C. Jesus calls her by name. **(John 10:3-4)**

- III. The Power of His Resurrection
 - A. The Past **(1 Corinthians 15:3-4)**
 - 1. Many bore witness to the Risen Jesus.
 - 2. Why would so many die for a lie?
 - B. The Present **(1 Corinthians 15:14, 17)**
 - 1. Testimony bears witness to His power.
 - 2. **Colossians 2:13-15**
 - a. Disarmed so we can walk in present victory.
 - b. Because He lives, I can face tomorrow!
 - C. The Future **(Matthew 21:9)**
 - 1. We all face mortality. **(1 Corinthians 15:21-22)**
 - 2. Good news at the Graveyard **(1 Cor. 15:54-55)**
